The Board acknowledged funds may need to be moved from committed funds to fund the project. Debbie motioned approval, Ginny seconded.
- Red Card Certification will take place in April.
- May 14<sup>th</sup> is the planned date for getting the foam jacking done to preserve the sidewalk at Station 3.
- Station Saturdays are scheduled for 17 Feb, 21 Apr, 23 June, where there
  will be training, team building, and food.
- Training is ongoing.
- Chief reported Stage test on type 3 engine looks good.
